All members of the Board were present, except the following: Director Bumpass thus constituting a quorum. Whereupon among other business, the following was transacted at such Meeting: A written



WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 8, Section 1-b of the Constitution of the State of Texas and pursuant to V.T.C.A., Tax Code §11.13(d), the Board of Directors (the "*Board*") of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 186 (the "*District*") is authorized to adopt exemptions from taxation of not less than \$3,000 of the appraised value of the residence homesteads of individuals who are disabled or are 65 years of age or older;

WHEREAS, the Board has been advised that granting such an exemption will not impair the District's obligation to levy taxes for payment of its debts or cause a substantial negative impact on the tax rolls of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board deems it appropriate to adopt such exemption;

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 186 THAT:

I.

Effective January 1, 2011 and thereafter until modified by order of the Board, an exemption of 20% of appraised values of residence homesteads and \$10,000 of the appraised value of residence homesteads within the District is available for individuals who are disabled or are 65 years of age or older.

II.

Such individuals may be granted such exemption upon direct application to the chief appraiser for the Harris County Appraisal District.

III.

The President or Vice President is authorized to execute and the Secretary or Assistant Secretary is authorized to attest this Order on behalf of the Board and to do all things necessary and proper to carry out the purposes and intent hereof.
