The President called the meeting to order in accordance with notice posted pursuant to law, copies of Certificates of Posting of which are attached hereto as Exhibits "A," and the following business was transacted:

1. **Discuss the Reclaimed Water Agreement.** Mr. Eckert presented to and reviewed with the Board a memorandum relating to the Reclaimed Water System design, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "B." Mr. Eckert noted that there is plenty of reclaimed water to meet the needs of the districts. The Board agreed that they need to coordinate with the WHCRWA since the WHCRWA will receive a significant benefit from the reclaimed water system.

Mr. Eckert was directed to prepare an allocation of the costs of the distribution lines for the participating districts.

It was the consensus to hold another meeting on Monday, April 3, 2006 at TC&B's office.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned.
